- Upon acceptance into WORK2LEARN, I understand I must register in the course WORK 120 (Skills for Employment) and the non-refundable fee of \$299 will be applied to my account.
- Eligibility to remain in WORK2LEARN will be based on my academic standing at the end of the F20 and W21 semesters, successful completion of WORK120 (Skills for Employment), active engagement in an independent job search and applying to at least 20% of all placement leads posted in CareerConnect, Humber's job board throughout the W21 term.
